3rd August 2016 - 13th August 2016

ToT Kolkata

The Training of Trainers Program (TOT) commenced on 3rd August 2016 at Salt Lake Institute of Management, Kolkata organized by IPSC. The event held for 10 days concluded on the 13th August'2016, was conducted as per the mandate from NSDC wherein all the Training Partners must have certified trainers to conduct the training under PMKVY 2. The program included 22 trainees who have cleared the pre-assessment test out of 41 trainees from different Training Partners of East Zone. The Training was imparted in two sessions i.e.

Domain Skills for 2 days and Platform Skills for 6 Days, with 2 additional days assigned for assessment for the respective skills.



Domain Skills Training was provided by Mr. Prassana Patro and Mr. Gautam Mukhopadhyay for 2 days. Platform Skills Training and Safety & health Training was provided by Mr. Prassana Patro for 6 days which included soft skills for providing training. During the training period Mr. Jyotirmoy Debnath was appreciated from all the trainees and trainers for making the Domain Skills presentation, motivational audio visual presentation and also given the valuable inputs to developing the attitude, presentation skills, body language, communication and overall IPSC activity. Most of the

candidates highlighted to enhance the period and course content on safety due to less awareness and knowledge related to safety and health and also domain skills module. It has to be taken care to provide more emphasis on safety and health related courseware in further training programs.
