5th January 2017

World Skill Competition Meeting

On 5th January 2017, a meeting was held at IPSC office to discuss the World Skill Competition. Mr Varun Tandon from IPSC coordinated the meetings to explore and access the level of skills of participants, trainings required and formulating the road map to participation World Skill Competition in Plumbing and Heating.

Mr Subhash Deshpande was invited from Pune for the same, to give his views as an expert in the field. Agenda of the meeting included interviews with the winners from Skill Competiti on during Plumbing Skills Mela 2016. Md. Tanveer Khan, Mr Istayak Ali and Mr Deepak Kumar Gupta were interviewed and their skill level was assessed by Mr Deshpande.



Subsequently, Mr Surinder Singh was invited for the meeting since he has attended the World Skill Competition 2011 held in London as an observer and shared his experience and presented his views on the level of training required for the same. According to Mr Singh, a lot needs to be improved in order to attain level that is required for participation in these competitions. He suggested improvements in the actual skills, drawing abilities, investing in international tools and being able to effectively use them. He also highlighted that the grooming of candidate is required not only in technical aspects but also in terms of the attitude, soft skills and overall confidence as these play an important role during the competitions as well. He opined that we should focus on World Skill Competition to be held in 2019.

Thereafter, Governing Body Members of IPSC and Members of Skill Competition Committee were invited for the final meeting with Mr Subhash Deshpande. Mr CS Gupta, Mr Vinay Gupta, Mr MK Gupta, Mr Gurmit Singh Arora participated in the meeting and discussions were held to ascertain Mr Deshpande opinion towards our participations in WSC 2017. It was decided to focus on WSC 2019 instead of 2017 and Mr Subhash Deshpande was deputed to attend the competition in 2017 as an observer. IPSC will focus on India's participation in Plumbing and Heating during World Skill Competition 2019. A tentative road map was also drafted during this meeting to initiate work for the same.

IPSC's Governing Body Meeting

The third Governing Body Meeting of Indian Plumbing Skills Council was held on 7th January 2017 at Hotel Crowne Plaza. Mr Mohan Reddy represented NSDC for the same. Several points were discussed such as the advocacy of IPSC and Skill India Mission, Ashirvad Plumbing School, IPSC's Membership and its deliverables.
